Dear Under Secretary General Fletcher,

The Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF) shares your values of humanity, impartiality, neutrality, and independence, and we have structured our entire operational model around them. As you know, our team has delivered more than 90 million meals across Gaza in only two months.

As we conveyed in our previous letter, and as was directed by the Secretary-General's office several weeks ago, we again respectfully request a meeting with you at your earliest availability. I understand that a similar request has been conveyed on multiple occasions by the Ambassador Dorothy Shea.

We believe this conversation is critical to opening lines of trust and coordination at the highest levels, especially as the crisis in Gaza continues to worsen by the day. We want to discuss with you an operational partnership and stand ready to proceed with one immediately. We hope your operations team has a similar attitude.

GHF stands ready to assist your teams in safely and rapidly moving the aid that is currently warehoused and immobilized inside Gaza, and we are open to flexible models of collaboration that protect the neutrality of aid and the dignity of those receiving it. We are the ones which continue to convey our flexibility and our willingness to adapt.

The UN's credibility, as well as the well-being of thousands, depend on all of us finding a better way forward.

GHF exists to be part of the solution, not to replace or rival any institution, but to help fill the gaps with transparency and effectiveness. We are willing to put our differences aside and to adapt to help people now.

I look forward to our meeting personally and to seeing your operations team and our team on the ground collaborating.

We want the opportunity to work side by side with you to feed the people of Gaza.
